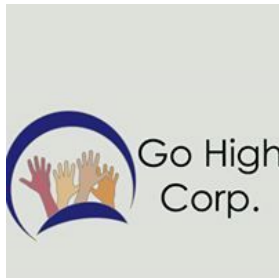

Family Day Events - Volunteers greet and welcome visitors, review the schedule of activities with them, and point them in the direction of activities; assist children at art stations; usher visitors into and out of performances; manage lines; aid staff, artists, and performers with setting up, managing, and cleaning up performance and work space areas and equipment; and help with other event-specific tasks that arise. Volunteers for these events should enjoy working with a diverse, multigenerational audience.

Open Studio Sundays - Volunteers assist the art instructors with preparing and cleaning materials and supplies; disseminating materials and providing instructions on the planned art projects to families who stop by; and talking to families about upcoming youth and family programs. Open Studios normally take place on the first Sunday of the month. Volunteers for Open Studios should enjoy interacting with children and families and being in an art studio setting.

Ask Me Ambassadors (AMAs) - AMAs serve as the welcoming face of VMFA. They help greet visitors, assist with way finding, check visitors' coats and parcels into and out of the complimentary coat check services, usher, take tickets, thank visitors, gather feedback on visitors' experiences, and perform other special assignments. AMAs should enjoy working with the public and have positive customer service and interpersonal skills. They should also be reliable, like working on a team, and be able to take initiative.

AMAs usually commit to a minimum of two 2½ hour shifts per month. Shifts are generally available daily from 9:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.; 12:00-2:30 p.m., and 2:30-5:00 p.m., and on Thurs. and Fri. evenings from 5:00-7:00 p.m. and 7:00-9:00 p.m.

Summer Art Adventure Camps - Volunteers assist with a variety of assignments which may include helping the instructors with preparing and cleaning materials and supplies; disseminating materials and guiding the students on the art activities; keeping the groups together during exploratory visits to the galleries and around campus; facilitating logistical aspects and learning activities during the lunch break; safely checking students into and out of

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the camps; etc.

Summer Art Adventure Camps for pre-school children take place in May, and then the full schedule of camps for pre-school, elementary, middle, and high school students take place from June through August. Volunteers who assist with camps are asked to commit to a full week at a time for continuity in the week-long sessions.
